## THE COLLEGE PROMISE COMMITMENT

The College Promise Program will provide a life changing opportunity for up to 500 Montgomery County students over a 10 year period. These students, whose lives have been impacted by poverty, will be identified and selected during their 8th grade year. Each student will be supported through high school by a caring adult mentor who will meet with them weekly for 30 to 50 minutes at their school and through programming offered by the College Promise Program and our partners.



The selected students, upon the successful completion of high school and the meeting of the entrance requirements of our college and university partners, will be awarded scholarships that allow them to attend college at little to no cost to them or their families.

## STUDENT AND PARENT/GUARDIAN COMMITMENT

The College Promise students will sign a contract that pledges they will be alcohol, tobacco and drug free; be crime free; practice good citizenship; maintain a strong record of school attendance; achieve the required grade point average; participate in school or community based activities; and attend weekly meetings with their mentors.



The College Promise parent/guardian will sign a contract that pledges they will provide a supportive home environment; develop a positive relationship with the College Promise staff; and attend open house/parent teacher conferences at their child's school.

## COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY ATTENDANCE

Each College Promise student who fulfills their pledge will earn a scholarship opportunity to attend Sinclair Community College to earn an Associate's Degree. Those who successfully complete their 2-year degree will earn a scholarship to attend Wright State University, Central State University, Miami University or Denison University to complete a Bachelor's Degree. A limited number of 4-year scholarships are also available at Kettering College and the University of Dayton.



## SPONSOR A SCHOLARSHIP

As a scholarship program sponsor with the Montgomery County Ohio College Promise Program, you will be forever impacting the life of a child through the gift of education.
