The launch has been off to a rocky start, so please encourage your mentees and their families to be persistent and not give up on the process. They can access it here: https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa. Remember, the student and at least one of their parents must sign up for their FSA ID on the Federal Student Aid website: https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch in order to complete the FAFSA. Last of all, please remind your mentees that it is absolutely critical for them to pay close attention to the FAFSA and application deadlines of our partner schools.
- 11th Cohort Mentors: Please mark your calendars for The College Promise Scholar Night, to be held on Thursday, 2/22/24 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in UD's Kennedy Union Ballroom. Correspondence with more details will be sent to students and their families soon. All mentees are expected to attend so that they can meet and interact with our college partners. Families and mentors are invited to attend as well.
